Holidays In Term Time

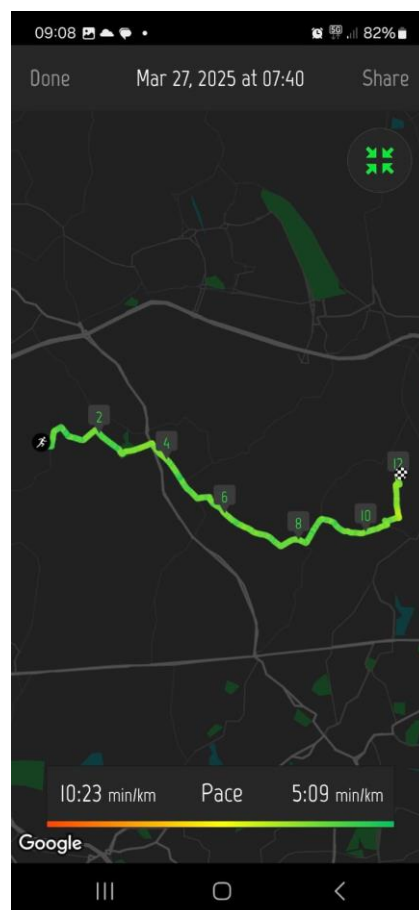
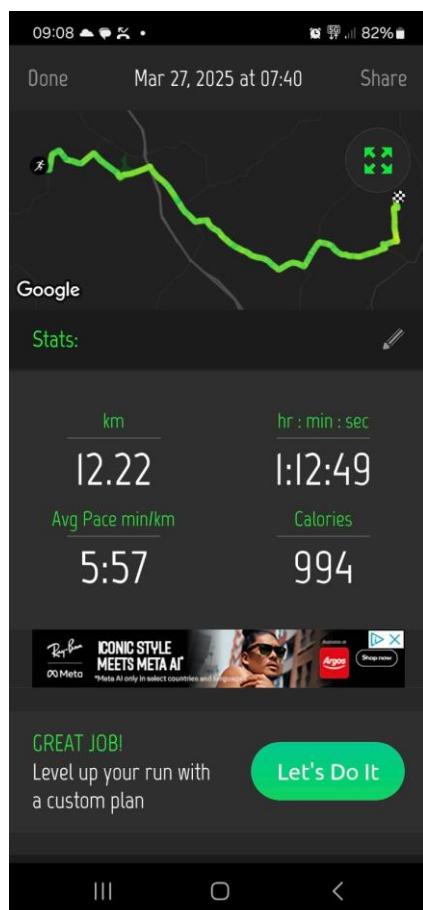
Parents requesting to take their child out of school for a family holiday during term time are now required to complete a Holiday Request Form prior to the holiday.
