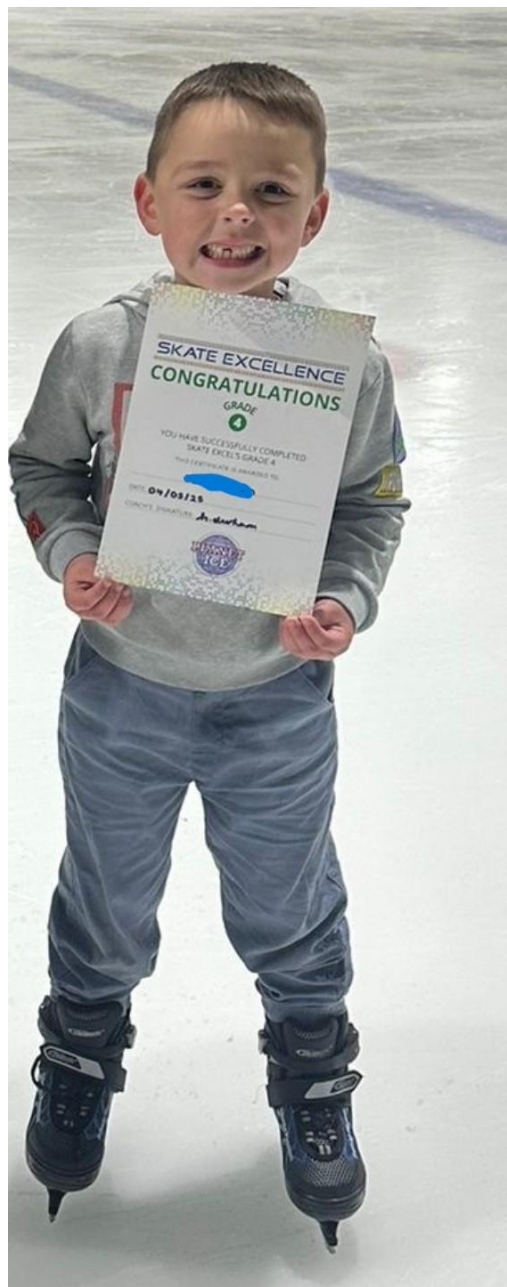
Corpus Christi Stars
