The children had a fantastic time this week taking part in Sports Day. Thank you to everyone who came along to support them and cheer them on!



# Walking Day 2025

Reminder of the arrangements for Walking Day on Saturday:

Corpus Christi children will leave school at 1.20pm. Children attending should meet and line upon the playground between 1:00pm and 1:15pm, where they will be registered before being walked down to All Saints Church by school staff. Late children should come directly to All Saints Church lawn and make themselves known to their teacher.

Children should wear smart clothes for the walk. Children who received their First Holy Communion recently are welcome to wear their Holy Communion clothing.

Walking Day begins with a short service at 2.00pm and the walk begins at around 2.15pm.

The school will walk behind the Corpus Christi banner, starting with Year 6 and finishing with Nursery. Children will walk in 3's with their class and accompanying adults. All Nursery and Reception children should be accompanied by an adult as a matter of safety.

We are also asking parents/carers if they would kindly volunteer to carry our banner for the duration of the walk and for any other volunteers who could walk with the school. This would be greatly appreciated. If we have a few volunteers this can be done on a rota basis.

At the end of the walk school will have light refreshments ready for all our children and volunteers to enjoy.

School will be accepting donations of cakes for this event. These can be brought to school from 10.00am onwards on the Saturday morning. All other parents, relatives and friends are invited to stay for refreshments.

Children can be collected and taken home at 4.00pm.
