Changes to School Payments

Starting in September 2025, our school will discontinue the use of Schoolmoney and will instead adopt 'mychildatschool.com'.

All parents have received a message through Schoolspider containing sign-up details. We encourage you to log into your new account and familiarise yourself with its features.

The new platform allows you to book sessions for breakfast and afterschool clubs in advance, as well as book same-day sessions, eliminating the need for the office to manage last-minute bookings. All sessions require payment at the time of booking. Any credit on your accounts will be carried across from Schoolmoney.

Additionally, you can cancel any unnecessary bookings directly through the app.

Please note that there will be no changes to the payment process for childcare vouchers and similar services.

The new payment system will also be used for trips, residentials and all other payments.
